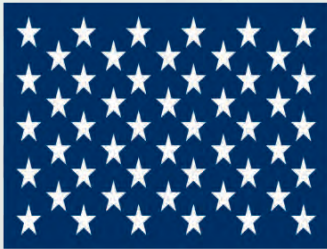

The Rev. James T. O'Reilly Division Eight Ancient Order of Hibernians

Division Eight was organized in Lawrence, Massachusetts on November 5, 1871, and for the past 155 plus years has helped preserve Irish culture, history, and traditions in a multifaceted way. The talents of its members have been recognized beyond the borders of the Lawrence area. Members have served on the AOH National, State and County Boards in both elective and appointive positions.

Division 8 has been involved in a host of community endeavors and has been supportive of a many charitable causes. The Division yearly hosts numerous social events, and has scholarship opportunities for members, the children, and grandchildren of members on the high school and college level, including a scholarship for study in Ireland.

The Division developed a collection of over 15,000 Irish books, media and memorabilia that is on permanent loan to the Lawrence Public Library in Lawrence. The Division has partnered on many cultural endeavors with the New England Irish Cultural Center in Canton, MA, the Burns Library at Boston College, the Boston Irish Tourism Association, the Irish Consul General's Office in Boston, and the Maine Irish Heritage Center in Portland Maine.

In 2006, Division 8 dedicated a memorial at the Immaculate Conception Cemetery to the victims of the great hunger in Ireland. Yearly the Division holds a memorial service at this memorial, to those lost during the Great Hunger in Ireland, as well as to our deceased members.

Locally, Division 8 AOH meets at the Lawrence Lodge of Elks, 652 Andover St in Lawrence on the second Wednesday of each month except for July and August. Membership is open to those who are 16 years of age or older; Irish by birth, descent, or adoption, and who are practicing Catholics.

The Richard Cardinal Cushing Award is named after the late Boston Catholic Irish prelate who died in November 1970. This award is awarded to an Irish Catholic of high moral character who exemplifies the characteristics of the late Richard Cardinal Cushing. The individual may be a man or woman, who through their life endeavors demonstrates in their daily lives the qualities of what an exemplary Irish Catholic should be.

The Hon. John E. Fenton Citizenship Award was established in 1975 to honor the late Judge John E. Fenton who passed in August 1974. Judge Fenton, who was a member of Division 8, went on to serve two terms as National President of the Ancient Order of Hibernians. This award is presented to a man, woman, or organization, without regard to their religious, or ethnic background, who has contributed in an outstanding manner to the betterment of Greater Lawrence and the Merrimack Valley area.

The Irishman of the Year Award is the highest award Division 8 can bestow on a member. This award was established in 1964, and is presented annually to a member of Division 8 AOH for his outstanding service, dedication, and contributions to Hibernianism and Division 8.

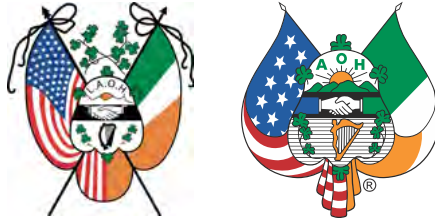



Incorporated February 24th, 1875. During the 16 years of their organization, they have paid \$8,967.00 for sick benefit, \$1,500.00 for death claims. It is one of the most flourishing branches of the order in this state, and at present, financially and numerically, ranks first in the country. It has at present membership of 327 and money on deposit to its credit of \$3,400.00, and personal property, hall, furniture, etc., valued at \$1,100.00. It is at present governed by the following officers: President, John F. McQueeney; Vice-President, Thomas F. Maloney; Recording Secretary, Michael Kelley; Financial Secretary, John O'Connor; Treasurer, George Ford.

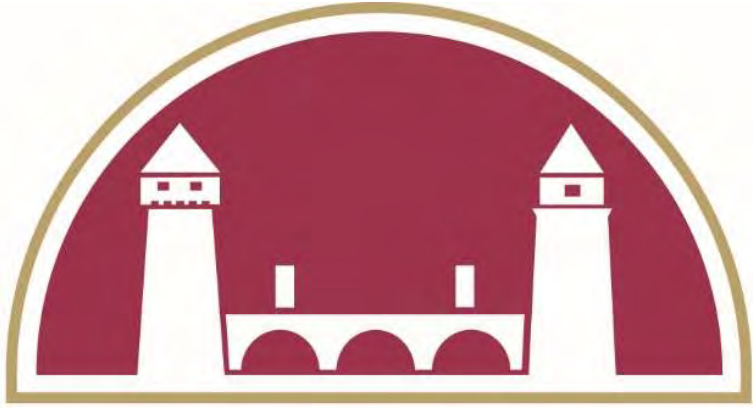
